

Notice of Application Nos. THUR 08-02, THUR 08-03, THUR 08-04, THUR 08-05, THUR 08-06, THUR 08-07, THUR 08-08, THUR 08-09, THUR 08-10, THUR 08-11, and THUR 08-12 to change the purpose of use, place of use, and points of withdrawal/diversion under the following certificates of water right and change certificates: Ground Water Certificate Nos. 785-D with Certificate of Change No. 621, 784-B with Certificate of Change No. 622, 34-A with Certificate of Change No. 620, 453-A with Certificate of Change No. 623, 4587-A, G2-01073 C, G2-01072 C, G2-20844 C, G2-23128 C, G2-26058 C, and Surface Water Certificate No. 6230 with Certificate of Change No. 87, respectively.

TAKE NOTICE: That on June 16, 2008, Jill Van Hulle of Pacific Groundwater Group on behalf of the Cities of Lacey, Olympia, and Tumwater (applicants), filed 11 applications for change of water rights with the Thurston County Water Conservancy Board (Board) to change the purpose of use, place of use, and points of withdrawal/diversion of water granted under the above listed certificates of water right and certificates of change. These water rights were originally issued to the former Olympia Brewing Company.

Ground Water Certificate 785-D and Certificate of Change No. 621 under the priority date of July 20, 1936, authorize the withdrawal of a total of 203 gallons per minute and 328 acre-feet per year from a well (Well 16) located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate 784-D and Certificate of Change No. 622 under the priority date of July 15, 1937, authorize the withdrawal of a total of 200 gallons per minute and 323 acre-feet per year from a well (Well 16) located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate 34-A and Certificate of Change No. 620 under the priority date of May 22, 1946, authorize the withdrawal of a total of 500 gallons per minute and 800 acre-feet per year from a well (Well 17) located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate 453A under the priority date of March 23, 1950, authorizes the withdrawal of 1000 gallons per minute, and 1600 acre-feet per year, and Certificate of Change No. 623, authorizes the change of a portion of the water right in the amount of 700 gallons per minute and 1,120 acre-feet per year from Well Nos. 9, 10, 11, 12, and 15 located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate 4587-A under the priority date of January 22, 1960, authorizes the withdrawal of a total of 250 gallons per minute and 3,600 acre-feet per year from Well Nos. 10, 11, 12, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for manufacturing purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate G2-01073 C under the priority date of January 23, 1967, authorizes the withdrawal of a total of 900 gallons per minute and 165 acre-feet per year from Well Nos. 26, 27, and 28 located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate G2-01072 C under the priority date of April 22, 1971, authorizes the withdrawal of a total of 900 gallons per minute and 40 acre-feet per year from Well Nos. 30, 32, and 33 located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for irrigation of an acre from April 13 to October 1, and for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate G2-20844 C under the priority date of March 13, 1973, authorizes the withdrawal of a total of 500 gallons per minute from Well Nos. 34, 35, and 36 located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate G2-23128 C under the priority date of September-10-1974, authorizes the withdrawal of a total of 250 gallons per minute from Well Nos. 37 and 38 located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Ground Water Certificate G2-26058 C under the priority date of January 12, 1982, authorizes the withdrawal of a total of 1,500 gallons per minute and 1,200 acre-feet per year from Well No. 39 located within Section 35, T. 18N., R. 2 W. W. M. for industrial purposes at the former Olympia Brewery property located westerly of the Olympia-Yelm Highway and easterly of Interstate Highway 5 within Sections 26 and 35, T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

Surface Water Certificate G2-26058 C and Certificate of Change No. 87 under the priority date of January 29, 1954, authorize the diversion of 1.01 cubic feet per second (454.8 gallons per minute) and an unspecified annual quantity of acre-feet per year from the Deschutes River within the NW 1/4 Section 1, T. 17N., R. 2 W. W. M. for irrigation of 100 acres from May 1 to October 1 each year, within T. 17N., R. 2 W.W.M. and T. 18N., R. 2W.W.M., within Thurston County.

That the applicants propose to change the purpose of use, place of use, and points of withdrawal for all the above-described ground water rights and surface water right to municipal supply water on a year-round basis to the service areas described in the most recent Water System Plans approved by the Washington State Department of Health for the Cities of Lacey, Olympia, and Tumwater in Thurston County.

The applicants propose to change the purpose of use and place of use as described above for the continued withdrawal of water from the following existing wells, previously authorized under the above water right certificates, Well Nos. 9, 10, 11, 13, 15, 16, 17, 19, 21, 24, 26, 27, 28, 30, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, and 39. In addition, the applicants propose to add up to 12 additional wells within the general vicinity of the Lumwater Valley Golf Course, within Section 35, T. 17N., R. 2W.W.M.

Any protests or objections to the approval of these applications may be filed with the Department of Ecology and must include a detailed statement of the basis for objections; protests must be accompanied by a fifty dollar (\$50) recording fee and filed with the Department of Ecology, Cashiering Unit, P.O. Box 47611, Olympia, WA 98504-7611 within thirty (30) days from August 8, 2008.

Any interested party may submit comments and other information to the Board regarding these applications. Comments and information may be submitted in writing or verbally at any public meeting of the Board held to discuss or decide on the applications. These applications will be on the Board agenda during its regular meetings to be held on August 18, 2008 and September 15, 2008. NOTE: this notice does not constitute notice of a meeting for the purposes of the Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 42.30 RCW.
