Notice of Application Nos. THUR 08-13, THUR 08-14 and THUR 08-15 to change the points of withdrawal under Ground Water Certificate Nos. 2924-A, 2723-A, and 480

TAKE NOTICE: That on November 17, 2008, the City of Tumwater filed three Applications for Change of water rights with the Thurston County Water Conservancy Board (Board) to change the point of withdrawal of water granted under the above referenced certificates of water rights. These water rights were previously held by the Port of Olympia.

Ground Water Certificate 2924-A (priority date June 18, 1948) authorizes the withdrawal of 25 gpm and 6.32 acre-feet per year for irrigation.

Ground Water Certificate 2723-A (priority date June 27, 1955) authorizes the withdrawal of 74 gpm and 20.4 acre-feet per year for irrigation.

Ground Water Certificate 480 (priority date November 28, 1947) authorizes the withdrawal of 30 gpm and 1.0 acre-feet per year for irrigation.

The currently authorized point of withdrawal for all three certificates is a proposed well to be located in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 10, T. 17 N., R. 2 W.W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the point of withdrawal for all three certificates to the site of Tumwater's Well 9 located in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 10, T. 17 N. R. 2 W.W.M. No other changes are proposed

Any protests or objections to the approval of these applications may be filed with the Department of Ecology and must include a detailed statement of the basis for objections; protests must be accompanied by a fifty dollar (\$50) recording fee and filed with the Department of Ecology, Cashiering Unit, P.O. Box 47611, Olympia, WA 98504-7611 within thirty (30) days from February 23, 2009.

Any interested party may submit comments and other information to the Board regarding these applications. Comments and information may be submitted in writing or verbally at any public meeting of the Board held to discuss or decide on these applications. These applications will be on the Board agenda during its regular meetings to be held on February 23, March 16, and April 20, 2009. NOTE: this notice does not constitute notice of a meeting for the purposes of the Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 42.30 RCW. Additionally, the Thurston County Water Conservancy Board may receive written comments or information through April 20, 2009 at its offices located at 626 Columbia Street NW, Suite 1-A, Olympia, WA 98501 or mailed to PO Box 1037, Olympia, WA 98501-1037.
