CERTIFICATE OF CHANGE OF POINT OF DIVERSION, AND PURPOSE AND PLACE OF USE OF SURFACE WATER

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto and rules thereunder of the State Director of Ecology.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that Olympia Brewing Company, of Olympia, Washington, has complied with all of the requirements of the Revised Code of Washington 90.01.360 and is hereby granted the right to change the point of diversion and purpose and place of use of 1.01 cubic feet per second, of the waters of unnamed springs and Deschutes River, tributary of Bull Inlet, as granted in Surface Water Certificate No. 6230.

That said water had been diverted at points located: 1) 1000 feet south and 1000 feet west of east quarter corner of Sec. 35 (Springs); and 2) Intersection of south line of Section 35 with River and points below (River), within Section 35, Township 16 North, Range 2 West W.M., Thurston County, Washington.

That they have changed the two points of diversion to one point of diversion only, with said one point being located on the Deschutes River approximately 900 feet south and 300 feet east from the northwest corner of Section 1, within the NW¹/₄ of Section 1, T. 17 N., R. 2 W.M.

That said 1.01 cubic feet per second of water had been used for domestic supply continuously, for fire protection as needed, and for irrigation of 100 acres from April 15 to October 1 each year.

That they have changed the purpose of use to only one use - i.e. that of irrigation of 100 acres from May 1 to October 1 each year.

That said 1.01 cubic feet per second of water had been used on the following described lands:

ENE¹/₄ of Sec. 35, T. 18 N., R. 2 W.M., LESS 5.26 acres and railroad right of way and roads. 74.74 acres.
SE¹/₄SW¹/₄ of Sec. 35, T. 18 N., R. 2 W.M., LESS 3.35 acres lying northerly of railroad. 16.67 acres.

SW¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Sec. 35, T. 18 N., R. 2 W.M., 4.00 acres
Sec. 35, T. 18 N., R. 2 W.M., 21.96 acres.
NE¹/₄SW¹/₄, Commencing 246.5 feet east and 30 feet south of west quarter section corner south 660 feet, east 844.29 feet, south 417.42 feet, east to east line, NW¹/₄SW¹/₄, south to center of SW¹/₄ west 1320 feet; thence north 1320 feet; thence east 246.5 feet, south 30 feet. LESS pt. to county for roads. LESS .77 Acres.
Sec. 36, T. 18 N., R. 2 W.M., 36.94 acres. LESS portion to county. LESS 2.06 acres for railroad right of way.

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That they have changed the place of use to the following:

beginning at a point on the south line of county road known as Olympia-Yelm Road 30 feet south and 940 feet west of the east quarter corner of Sec. 35; thence south 1°42'30" west 2635 feet more or less to the south line of Sec. 35; thence east along the south line of Sec. 35 to the southeast corner of Sec. 35; thence south 2°51'07" west 950 feet more or less to the centerline of the Deschutes River; thence north and east along the centerline of the Deschutes River to the west line of county road known as Gleason Road; thence northerly along the west line of Gleason Road to the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road; thence westerly along the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road to the point of beginning; EXCEPTING those portions of the NW1/4 of Sec. 36, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road 30 feet south and 546.5 feet east of the west quarter corner of Sec. 36; thence south 159 feet; thence west 300 feet; thence north 159 feet more or less to the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road; thence east along the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road 300 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

beginning at a point on the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road 30 feet south and 790.29 feet east of the west quarter corner of Sec. 36; thence south 175.5 feet; thence south 86°51' east 125.03 feet; thence north 178 feet more or less to the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road; thence west along the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road 125 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

beginning at a point on the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road 30 feet south and 1110.79 feet east of the west quarter corner of Sec. 36; thence south 178.71 feet; thence east 178.71 feet more or less to the west line of Gleason Road; thence north along the west line of Gleason Road 178.71 feet more or less to the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road; thence west along the south line of Olympia-Yelm Road 178.71 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING ALSO the right of way of Oregon-Washington Navigation Company and public roads.

EXCEPTING ALSO from the above described main tract that part lying southerly of right of way of Oregon-Washington Navigation Company and being approximately 30 acres which is enclosed by fence line of Tumwater Valley Development Company

ALSO TO BE INCLUDED: That portion of NE1/4 of Sec. 2, T. 17 N., R. 2 W.W.M. lying northerly and easterly of the Deschutes River.

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that JOSEPH WIGLER
of Olympia, State of Washington, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use
of the waters of Donchuton River
unopened springs and /, a tributary of Budd Inlet
with point or points of diversion within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Sec. 35, Twp. 18 N., R. 2 W., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in
Appropriation Permit No. 9580 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and
that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
record in Volume 13, at Page 6230, on the 1st day of August, 1955
that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is January 29, 1954; that the
amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount
actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.01 cubic feet per second for the
purposes of domestic supply, fire protection and the irrigation of
100 acres.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35, Twp. 18 N., Rge. 2 W.W.M. Less 5.26 acres and
Railroad right-of-way and roads. 74.7 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres.

E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35, Twp. 18 N., Rge. 2 W. W. M. Less 3.33
acres lying northerly of Railroad. 16.67 acres.

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35, Twp. 18 N., Rge. 2 W.W.M. 40 acres.

Sec. 36, Twp. 18 N., Rge. 2 W.W.M. 2190 acres. NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, commencing
246.5 feet East and 30 feet South of W $\frac{1}{2}$ section corner South 660 feet,
East 644.29 feet, South 417.42 feet, East to East line, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, South
to center of SW $\frac{1}{4}$; West 1320 feet; thence North 1320 feet; thence East
246.5 feet, South 30 feet. Less pt. to county for roads. Less .77 acre.

Sec. 36, Twp. 18 N., Rge. 2 W.W.M. 36.94 acres. Less portion to
county. Less 2.06 acres for railroad right-of-way.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
